### Action Taken Report on Feedback reports

Action Taken Report on Feedback reports as initiated by the Governing Council (GC) of the College.

To consider the feedback/ suggestion given by the stake holders on various issues affecting performance of students/institute and Action Taken Report (ATR) on it:

#### I. From Students

a. *Students who have shown outstanding performance have requested for increase in number of books issued for home lending.*

ATR : The fees for membership of professional bodies are being reimbursed by the college partly or completely as per demand of staff.

#### c. For study tours, industrial visits all staff should be asked to attain.

ATR : The procedure was followed earlier as number of students were too less (upto 2012) but now we allow each department to conduct their industrial visits. So, it is practically not possible. But, it is suggested to all departments to arrange visits, study tours at some place and on some day so that more number of students and teachers will take part in to the activity.

ATR : AFS has indicated the process to extend support to neo-entrepreneurs including "start up" companies.

ATR : Placement process is carried out as per the directives of company and as it is carried for only last year appearing students, alumni can not take part. However, placement cell will try to send other requirements of jobs related to alumni like consultancy at its cost.

V. From Employers

a. *Communication skills need to be developed.*

*AIR : This suggestion was made in the year 2017-2018 itself. Every effort is being made to improve the communication skills of students.*
